

WHAT IS CAMP HUDØY?

Camp Hudøy is a summer camp run by Stiftelsen Hudøy, a collaboration between Oslo municipality and Kirkens Bymisjon. All pupils in Oslo who are now in grades 2-7 can apply for a place on Camp Hudøy, and the places are distributed by lottery. Every summer, the island is filled with 425 children and 120 staff, spread over 11 different camp sites where you live, play, eat and sleep together for either 5 or 12 days. Throughout the summer holidays, we have room for over 1,370 children at Hudøy.

GROWN UPS - READ HERE!

Why not let the children go on summer camp to beautiful Hudøy in the Oslofjord while you work this summer? Here they can swim, play football, fish for crabs, play in the forest, learn to sail, read books and get home-cooked meals. The children return with a backpack full of experiences and new friendships!

#LOGONTOLIFE

This year we organize a summer camp on Hudøy for the 106th time. Hudøy is an old fashioned holiday where mobile phones have been replaced with friendship bracelets. Here we log off our devices and create new memories without them being filtered through social media. We simply say: On Hudøy we log off, so we can log on to life.

EXPERIENCED STAFF

Our purpose is to create good summer memories for children and young people in safe surroundings. We have skilled and committed employees whom we recruit from colleges and universities in Norway. Before the children arrive, the staff receive training in safety and first aid from the management and the health service on the island. In total, over 120 people work to create a safe holiday for the children.


